The Bicycle Amendment Bylaw, 2023

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9874, The Bicycle Amendment Bylaw, 2023 ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw amends the definition of "power-assisted bicycle" to mirror the new definition in *The Registration Exemption and Reciprocity* Regulations, 2014.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9874, The Bicycle Amendment Bylaw, 2023.

BACKGROUND

At its December 19, 2022 Regular Business Meeting, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction dated December 5, 2022, and resolved:

> That the definition of power assisted bicycles in Bylaw No. 9705, *The Bicycle* Bylaw, 2020 be updated to include the definition for power-assisted bicycle under The Registration Exemption and Reciprocity Regulations, 2014; and

> > **DELEGATION: Cindy Yelland**

That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendment to Bylaw No. 9705, The Bicycle Bylaw, 2020.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council's instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9874, The Bicycle Amendment Bylaw, 2023 for City Council's consideration.

As a housekeeping amendment, the definition of "bicycle" has been expanded to include "belt-driven" bicycles in addition to chain-driven and shaft-driven bicycles.
