I am against the proposed plan to improve main and Clarence

Although I recognize the issue of frequent collisions, I believe the current plan will only move the location of collisions from main and Clarence to 9th and Clarence or 10th and Clarence. 9th and 10th are both narrower streets (essentially 1 way in the winter) and we're not designed to handle the additional traffic and collisions that happen in these other street may result in increased damages due to space restrictions.

I do believe the frequent accidents on main and Clarence do need to be addressed, but pushing the issues to other streets, is not the solution.
