Comments:

I write in support of the initiative to restrict traffic at the intersection of Main and Clarence. Main Street sees a higher

volume of traffic than one would expect for a residential street, but more importantly, those who do drive on it tend to drive faster and more aggressively than on other similar streets nearby. Drivers can easily drive on 8th street for their through-traffic needs. Since the city has designated it as a active transportation route, I would hope that an option to allow bicycles (who clearly cannot safely travel on 8th street) would be accommodated to travel straight through the intersection.
