My husband and I chose to live here on Avenue J and 17th because it is close to walking and biking paths, as well as the river and the farmers' market (too bad that moved due to City policies and demands). WE find it now very difficult and unsafe to access 17th street from Ave J as traffic is very heavy and will be much heavier if the extension goes ahead. Visibility is very poor at the corner of 17th and J due to all the cars parked on 17th. There is an increased amount of traffic and big trucks will be even worse with the extension. Four lane traffic coming from the west will have nowhere to go once they get to Ave D or E and definitely not when they arrive at Spadina crescent west where there is a ridiculous corner. Residents along 17th and west of Avenue P were not considered at all when 11th was closed. The only people considered at that time were residents at the east end of 11th. This 17th street extension would be a major mistake and MUST BE TAKEN OFF OF CITY PROJECTS.
