ISSUE

Planning and Development is responsible for overall land use planning for the City of Saskatoon. The primary goal of the Department is to build an increasingly sustainable community over time, with an enhanced quality of life consistent with the vision and policies contained in [Bylaw 9700, Official Community Plan Bylaw, 2020](#).

The activities and mandate of the Department are achieved through a variety of targeted programs, policies and incentives and involve a wide range of community partners, including housing providers, Business Improvement Districts, community associations, land developers, builders, Local Area Plan committees and residents.
