

APPROVAL REPORT

The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9886, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. This Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to expand the Fringe Festival parking area, prohibit the misuse of Fringe Festival and Exhibition Week parking permits and make other minor amendments.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9886, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)*.

BACKGROUND

At its [March 29, 2023 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services dated March 7, 2023, and resolved in part:

That the proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*, as outlined in the report of the Community Services Division dated March 7, 2023, be approved; and

That the City Solicitor be requested to make the necessary amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*.
