

APPROVAL REPORT

The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Amendment Bylaw, 2023

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9892, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Amendment Bylaw, 2023* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw amends *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Bylaw, 2010* to allow eligible property owners to defer the costs of replacing certain sewer connections for terms of one, three, five and ten years.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9892, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Amendment Bylaw, 2023*.

BACKGROUND

At its [March 29, 2023 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction dated March 7, 2023, and resolved that:

The proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 8880, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Bylaw, 2010*, as outlined in the March 7, 2023 report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction, be approved; and

The City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate amendments to Bylaw No. 8880, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Bylaw, 2010*.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9892, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Amendment Bylaw, 2023* for City Council’s consideration.

The Bylaw includes various housekeeping amendments, including the addition of headers and the repeal of section 13.9 due to that provision no longer being relevant.
