I wish to express my full support to the amendment to allow for High Density Mixed Use land designation. As a physical activity consultant, I have worked with numerous communities in assiting them identify how to increase physical activity through programs and infrastructure design. A basic principle in what I do is to look at existing amenities that support physical activity and the same applies to increasing our density as a city. Instead of focusing on urban sprawl, which comes with incredible additional costs for infratstructure support, we should be looking for creative, unique and supportive opportunities to increase our urban density. This is most applicable when applied to land that is adjacent or in proximity to our river bank park and trail systems; access to downtown; access to active transportation routes and BRT; and access to existing commercial/retail servcices. We need to build for the future and not just our current need of the day.
