Good morning – please advise when the next full Council meeting might be held that could accommodate a 3 to 5 minute delivery regarding a July 27th city-wide appearance by 431 Air Demonstration Squadron 'Snowbirds'.

As the aerial tribute is planned to encompass the entire city (currently scheduled for 1155 – 1225, July 27), all Wards will be covered – in turn, there lies the potential and/or probability for each Councillor to be questioned by citizens as to what is happening that day. This in-person briefing is simply to update everyone on the aerial activity, it's purpose and to answer any questions that may surface; all would hear the same info at the same time.

The 'Salute to a Safe Saskatoon' initiative is being coordinated under Saskatoon Crime Stoppers' umbrella and has already been reviewed with Saskatoon Police, Fire, Medavie, Saskatoon Airport, NavCan, among others; the activity has already received approval through the City Manager's Office however I suspect Council would not be aware of the scope or reason for the tribute.

While a community-wide project such as this might not 'necessitate' an in-Council brief, having produced the local Air Show from 1995 to 2017, it has long been demonstrated that advance information is preferred by Council when possible.

Please let me know what the next possible date might be for either a publicly attended Council Meeting or if preferred, a closed presentation if deemed to be applicable. The attached 'cursory' overview can be utilized as an initial advisory.
