

The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9903, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)* ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to create two off-leash dog parks for small dogs; one in Charlottetown Park and one in Hyde Park.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9903, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)*.

BACKGROUND

At its [June 27, 2022 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services dated June 13, 2022, and resolved:

1. That subject to final design, a half-acre north addition to Hyde Dog Park be designated as a small dog off-leash dog park;
2. That subject to final design, one acre be designated within Charlottetown Park as a small dog off-leash dog park; and
3. That the City Solicitor be requested to amend Bylaw No. 7860, *The Animal Control Bylaw, 1999*, to designate the corresponding spaces in Hyde Park and Charlottetown Park as official off-leash areas.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council's instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9903, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)* for City Council's consideration.
