The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9903, The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2) ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to create two off-leash dog parks for small dogs; one in Charlottetown Park and one in Hyde Park.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9903. The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw. 2023 (No. 2).

BACKGROUND

At its June 27, 2022 Regular Business Meeting, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services dated June 13, 2022, and resolved:

- 1. That subject to final design, a half-acre north addition to Hyde Dog Park be designated as a small dog off-leash dog park;
- 2. That subject to final design, one acre be designated within Charlottetown Park as a small dog off-leash dog park; and
- That the City Solicitor be requested to amend Bylaw No. 7860, The Animal 3. Control Bylaw, 1999, to designate the corresponding spaces in Hyde Park and Charlottetown Park as official off-leash areas.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council's instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9903, The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2) for City Council's consideration.
