For the past 11 years, I have been riding my bike to work almost every day. I biked on days with windchills lower than -50, wearing three pairs of gloves. That doesn't scare me. I bike on ice and snow, on gravel and wet leaves. That doesn't scare me.

You know what scares me. It's the thought that one day, my bright orange coat and bright blue helmet and shining lights won't save me.

On May 24, bicyclist Natasha Fox was killed by a cement truck at an intersection that is known to everyone who has ever ridden past there as absolutely terrifying.

We need a city for humans, not cars. Humans who walk, and cycle, and take the bus, and yes, of course, who drive. We need safe infrastructure for pedestrians, cyclists, people with mobility challenges -- for everyone. Not just for drivers. Providing safe infrastructure for *all* residents will make Saskatoon a better place to live. Please make it so.
