Honorable Mayor and City Councillors:

I ride my bike every day throughout Saskatoon. While I usually find suitable routes that are reasonably convenient, numerous locations are particularly dangerous and unsafe for cyclists. The intersection of College Drive and Wiggins Avenue is among the most dangerous.

I am aware that Councillor Block (Ward 6) has introduced motions to council that would attempt to address cycling safety concerns at this intersection, which motions include:

- a third party road safety audit at the intersection of College and Wiggins
- funding for the road safety audit
- an update on the implementation of the Active Transportation Plan
- a budget option for an annual Road Safety Audit program

These and future motions that address safety for people riding bikes are urgently needed in Saskatoon and have my full support.
