RE: Request for Bylaw Change (Zoning Bylaw 8770)

On behalf of the Saskatoon & Region Home Builders' Association (SRHBA), I am writing to request for consideration of options available to address aesthetic concerns resulting from the additional green bins recently rolled out by the city. With the addition of the new green bins, this has resulted in up to 3 bins being stored in front of homes, and up to 6 bins where secondary suites are provided. This is not only unsightly, but it also affects the street appeal of the homes. While we appreciate the city's efforts to promote environmental sustainability, the current arrangement of storing these bins in front of homes has resulted in aesthetic issues that we believe can be addressed through a small change to the bylaws.

While rear land pick up would be ideal for those houses that have rear lane access, which we also recommend, we recognize this will not solve the issue for a substantial portion of homes. We therefore are requesting that the bylaws be changed to allow for 1.2-metre enclosures for the storage of waste bins, from the 1 metre currently permitted. It is important to note that many municipalities, including Regina, Edmonton, Winnipeg, and Brandon, already have 1.2 metres (or 4 feet) as their maximum allowable height for front yard enclosures.

Thank you for your time and consideration of our request. Of course, we recognize that these enclosures will need to have sliding access or will need to be set back far enough to ensure that doors don't open onto sidewalks. This change, while small, would allow homeowners and builders to provide enclosures for the bins, which would greatly improve the street appeal of the homes and neighborhoods in our city.
