Recommendation of the Committee

That the City Solicitor be requested to amend Bylaw No. 7990, *The Fire and Protective Services Bylaw, 2001* to add Diwali and Lunar New Year as two additional days where low hazard fireworks are permitted.

History

The Standing Policy Committee on Environment, Utilities and Corporate Services, at its meeting held on August 8, 2023, considered a report of the Saskatoon Fire regarding the above. The following people spoke to Committee:
