
## **ZONING NOTICE - NUTANA NEIGHBOURHOOD**

PROPOSED ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 9917 THE ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2023 (NO. 16)

Saskatoon City Council will consider an amendment to Bylaw No. 8770, Zoning Bylaw, 2009 proposed by Modus Ventures Corp. to rezone 509 12th Street East in the Nutana Neighbourhood. By way of Bylaw No. 9917, The Zoning Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 16), the subject site is proposed to be rezoned from PUD — Planned Unit Development District to B5B — Broadway Commercial District, subject to a Zoning Agreement.

## **LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

• Lot D, Block A2, Plan 101429175



**REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT** – The proposed rezoning will facilitate the development of an eight-storey commercial/office building with main floor commercial space, structured parking, and a limited number of dwelling units at this location. A Zoning Agreement is proposed for the site, which is a legal agreement that establishes site-specific regulations for how a property may be developed and used. A corresponding application to amend the Official Community Plan in relation to this site is also proposed.
