

# Detention Flowchart

## Prior to Detention

Officer Attends to Call for Service, identifying the nature and subject of the call

Is situation criminal?

Officer assesses public safety concerns

They are intoxicated or breaching the peace.

Take any necessary steps:  
• Move them along if they can care for themselves  
• Contact shelters, brief detox unit or other community resources  
• Contact sober friend/relative to care for them.  
• Contact PACT  
• Voluntary mental health assessment  
• Section 20 - mental health apprehension

Can they be released on paperwork?

They are taken to detention.

If none of the above are appropriate, take to detention.

## During Detention

Release on Undertaking

Paramedic Assessment  
Regular cell checks 15|30|60

If necessary:  
• Administer prescription drugs  
• Consult with community paramedics for further support/resources  
• Provide meals  
• Contact PACT or Mobile Crisis  
• Send to hospital

## Release from Detention

Individual is ready to be released

How to release?

Transport to court

Release on Undertaking

Supports Required?  
• Bus Pass  
• Outreach  
• Shelter  
• Housing  
• Cold Weather Strategy

Can they care for themselves?

Take any necessary steps:  
• Contact shelters, brief detox unit or other community resources  
• Contact sober friend/relative to care for them.  
• Contact PACT  
• Voluntary mental health assessment  
• Section 20 - mental health apprehension
