

APPROVAL REPORT

The Fire and Protective Services Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9927, *The Fire and Protective Services Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9927, *The Fire and Protective Services Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)*.

BACKGROUND

At its [September 27, 2023 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered 2 reports of the Saskatoon Fire Department dated September 5, 2023 and resolved:

1. That Option 2 be adopted for addressing carbon monoxide alarms as required in the Saskatchewan Fire Regulations; and
2. That the City Solicitor be instructed to draft the required amendments to Bylaw No. 7990, *The Fire and Protective Services Bylaw, 2001*.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s resolution, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9927, *The Fire and Protective Services Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 2)* for City Council’s consideration.

As a housekeeping amendment, the Bylaw also repeals and replaces the definitions section of *The Fire and Protective Services Bylaw, 2001* to modernize formatting and make various other minor changes, including updating definitions related to fireworks to align with current federal legislation.
