### The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)

#### ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9929, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to change speed limits on certain streets within the City.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9929, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)*.

#### BACKGROUND

At its [October 25, 2023 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction Department dated October 3, 2023 and resolved:

1. That the speed limit on McOrmond Drive between College Drive and Brighton Common be revised from 50 km/h to 60 km/h;
2. That the speed limit description for Zimmerman Road be updated to reflect a speed limit of 60 km/h from Highway No. 16 to a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway and a speed limit of 80 km/h from a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway to College Drive; and
3. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*, effective January 1, 2024.

#### DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s instruction, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9929, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)* for City Council’s consideration.

As a housekeeping amendment, two references to John A MacDonald Road have been updated to miyo-wâhkôhtowin Road.
