Purpose

The functions of the Committee shall be to provide an appeal process for those who are denied access to the Access Transit, as outlined in the report of the General Manager, Utility Services Department, dated August 21, 2001, based on the following criteria:

- a) Registration for Access Transit is denied because it would contravene the eligibility criteria;
- b) A request for subscription service is denied because it would contravene the requirements under the Subscription Policy;
- c) An individual is suspended from using the service as a result of violations under the No-show Policy; and/or
- d) An individual is suspended from using the service as a result of violations under the Cancellation Policy.

Composition

Total Membership 5
Appointed/Nominated by Council 5

(The Board shall consist of the same 5 appointees who form the City Mortgage Appeals Board.)*

Qualifications

- Knowledge and understanding of barriers to accessibility for disabled and elderly persons:
- Ability to provide rational solutions to complex problems; and
- Ability to assess information and make objective decisions.

Reporting

Independent. All decisions of the Board are final. There is no further appeal process.
