

2024 Appointments – Partners for the Saskatchewan River Basin

ISSUE

City Council makes an annual appointment to Partners for the Saskatchewan River Basin.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Governance & Priorities Committee recommend to City Council that Tyla Yobb be reappointed as the city representative to Partners for the Saskatchewan River Basin for 2024.

BACKGROUND

Appointments are made in accordance with [Policy C01-003 Appointments to Civic Boards, Commissions, Authorities, and Committees](#) and pursuant to Council resolution that an annual appointment by the City of Saskatoon is to be made to the Partners for the Saskatchewan River Basin. The appointment has typically been a member of City administration.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

Partners for the Saskatchewan River Basin is a non-profit charitable organization that involves a network of partners committed to increasing stewardship of the river basin by developing:

- Public awareness and education tools to teach the importance of the basin's biodiversity
- Partnerships and networks of organizations that cross political and sector boundaries
- Action projects people can participate in

Twyla Yobb, Watershed Protection Manager, Utilities and Environment Division has been the appointed member since 2019.

City Council considers city representative appointments for external boards at its November 22, 2023 Regular Business meeting.
