The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9929, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)* ("Bylaw") for City Council's consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council's decision to change speed limits on certain streets within the City.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9929, The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4).

BACKGROUND

At its October 25, 2023 Regular Business Meeting, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction Department dated October 3, 2023 and resolved:

- 1. That the speed limit on McOrmond Drive between College Drive and Brighton Common be revised from 50 km/h to 60 km/h;
- That the speed limit description for Zimmerman Road be updated to reflect a speed limit of 60 km/h from Highway No. 16 to a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway and a speed limit of 80 km/h from a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway to College Drive; and
- 3. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*, effective January 1, 2024.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council's instruction, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9929, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)* for City Council's consideration.

As a housekeeping amendment, two references to John A MacDonald Road have been updated to miyo-wâhkôhtowin Road.
