

## **Excerpts of Relevant Sections of Bylaw No. 7200, The Traffic Bylaw**

### **Part IV – Stopping and Parking**

#### **No Stopping Certain Locations**

13. The operator of a vehicle shall not stop the vehicle in any of the places listed in Schedule No. 2 except when necessary to avoid collision or conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic sign or signal.

#### **Schedule No. 2 No Stopping**

10. Within 15 metres of a pedestrian corridor or as otherwise indicated by a traffic sign.

### **Part V – Driving and Operating a Vehicle**

#### **U-turns**

27. (2) Subject to Subsections (3) and (4), the driver of a vehicle shall only be permitted to make a U-turn:
- a) at an unsignalized median opening; and
  - b) at an unsignalized intersection, provided that neither street is a private road or driveway, or lane or alley.
- (3) Notwithstanding Subsections (3), no driver of a vehicle shall make a U-turn at any unsignalized median opening or intersection, where a sign has been erected at that location prohibiting such movement.
- (4) Notwithstanding subsection (2), no driver of a vehicle shall make a U-turn anywhere in:
- a) a school zone when reduced speed limits are in effect; or
  - b) a school area.

### **Part VIII – Use of Bridges**

#### **Traffic Bridge (3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue – Victoria Avenue)**

50. (1) A person shall not drive or tow across the Traffic Bridge a vehicle or farm equipment that has a gross vehicle weight exceeding 5,000 kilograms.
- (2) A person shall not drive or tow across the Traffic Bridge a vehicle of a width exceeding 2.1 metres or of a height exceeding 2.6 metres.
