c) To make recommendations for plan improvements not arising out of plan surpluses, which are made to the City and the employee organizations as subjects to be dealt with as part of the collective bargaining process between the parties.

with an equal number of employer representatives.

Qualifications Must understand the benefits offered under the General

Quorum Ten (Five from each of employer/employee group appointees)

Term Members remain members until replaced by appointing parties.

Historically, Committee members remain in place until resignation or

termination.

Trustees - General Superannuation Plan (February/March; May/June;

August/September; and November/December)
