

BYLAW NO. 9929**The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)**

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 4)*.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Traffic Bylaw* to:
 - (a) change the maximum speed on McOrmond Drive between College Drive and Brighton Common from 50 km/h to 60 km/h;
 - (b) change the description of the maximum speed on Zimmerman Road to reflect a maximum speed of:
 - (i) 60 km/h from Highway No. 16 to a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway; and
 - (ii) 80 km/h from a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway to College Drive; and
 - (c) update references from John A. MacDonald Road to miyo-wâhkôhtowin Road.

Bylaw No. 7200 Amended

3. *The Traffic Bylaw* is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

Schedule No. 4 Amended

4. (1) Clause 5(bb) of Schedule No. 4 is amended by striking out “College Drive” and substituting “Brighton Common”.

(2) Clause 5(dd) of Schedule No. 4 is repealed and the following substituted:

“(dd) Zimmerman Road from Highway No. 16 to a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway;”.

(3) Clause 7(o) of Schedule No. 4 is repealed and the following substituted:

“(o) Zimmerman Road from a point 200 metres north of Meadows Parkway to College Drive;”.

Schedule No. 15 Amended

5. (1) Section 41 of Schedule No. 15 is amended by striking out “John A. MacDonald” and substituting “miyo-wâhkôhtowin”.

(2) Section 58 of Schedule No. 15 is amended by striking out “John A. MacDonald Drive” and substituting “miyo-wâhkôhtowin Road”.

Coming into Force

6. This Bylaw comes into force on January 1, 2024.
