ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9942, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 5)* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9942, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2023 (No. 5)*.

BACKGROUND

At the [2024/25 Preliminary Corporate Business Plan and Budget meetings](#) held on November 28, 29, 30 and December 1, 2023, City Council received reports of the Chief Financial Officer requesting approval to establish rates and fees and resolved in part:

That the City Solicitor be instructed to prepare appropriate amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*.

At its [November 22, 2023 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction dated November 1, 2023, and resolved:

1. That the amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*, as outlined in the November 1, 2023 report of the Transportation and Construction Division, be approved; and
2. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*.
