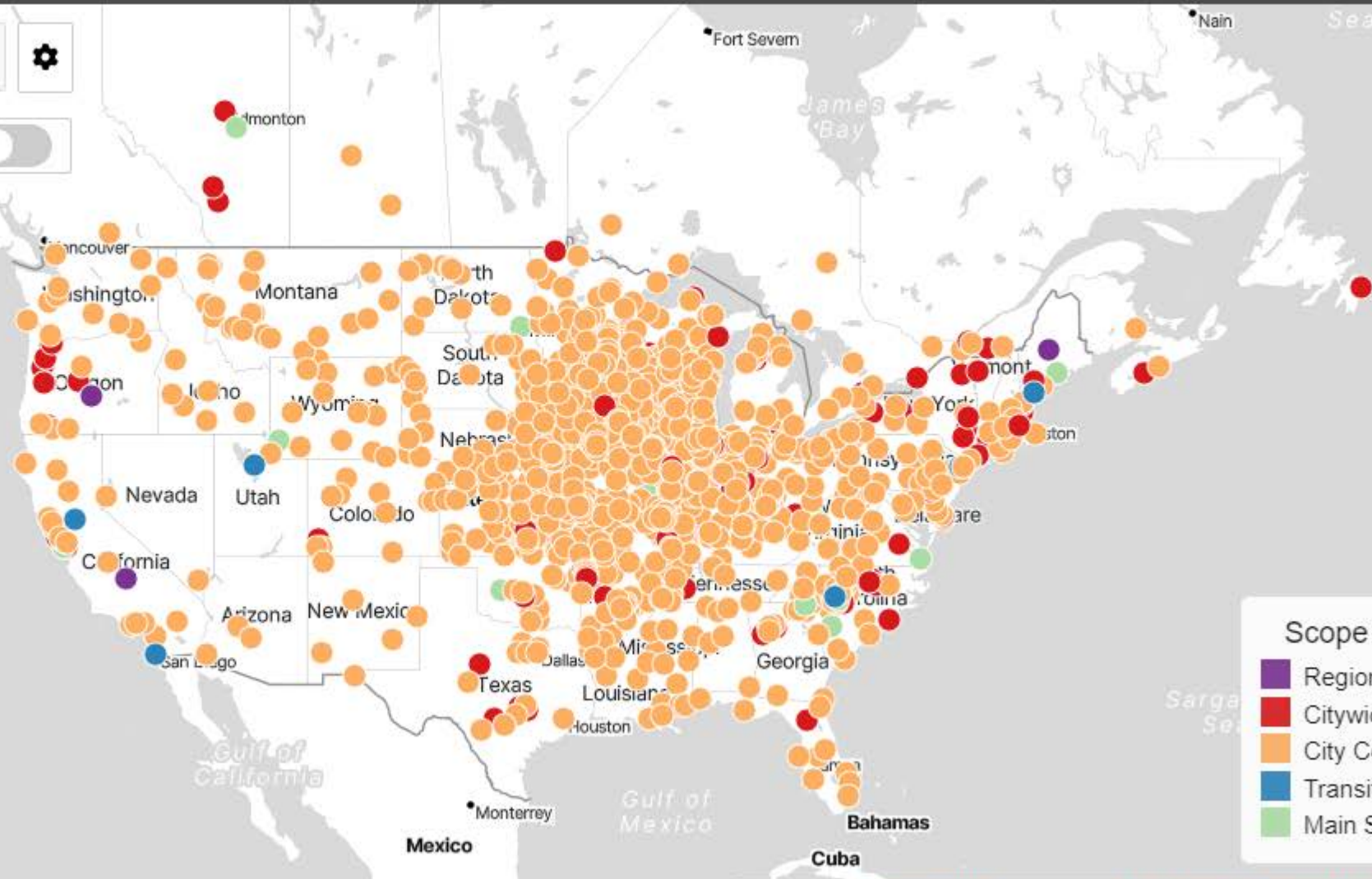
Parking Reform Map
