## **BACKGROUND**

At the <u>2024/25 Preliminary Corporate Business Plan and Budget meetings</u> held on November 28, 29, 30 and December 1, 2023, City Council received reports of the Chief Financial Officer requesting approval to establish rates and fees and resolved in part:

That the City Solicitor be instructed to prepare appropriate amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*.

At its <u>November 22, 2023 Regular Business Meeting</u>, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Transportation and Construction dated November 1, 2023, and resolved:

- That the amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, The Traffic Bylaw, as outlined in the November 1, 2023 report of the Transportation and Construction Division, be approved; and
- 2. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the appropriate bylaw amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*.
