Hi,

I am writing to City Council to ask that you support the better protection of trees in Saskatoon that are owned by the

City. Hence, I am asking you to support the proposed Tree Protection Bylaw.

Trees contribute to the quality of life in Saskatoon; and they require a long time to grow to a substantial size. Our trees make neighborhoods more attractive and pleasant to live in. They also help in addressing climate change, including by lowering the temperature in their vicinity. On hot summer days, I avoid walking in unshaded areas, and have enjoyed walking in the older neighborhoods shaded by elms.

Construction puts trees at risk due to the possibility of being hit by equipment and due to compaction of soil. Our trees on City property are an asset. A legal requirement for measures to avoid damage to trees during construction seems appropriate to me.
