## Comments:

This corridor is vital to our family. I am so grateful to live in Mayfair and be close to amenities but the current infrastructure makes it dangerous and often unpleasant for my family (kids aged 4,2). We take the 33rd street shared path by both foot and by bike to get to businesses in Uptown like Darkside Donuts, Universal Church Supplies, Saskatoon Academy of Music, or in City Park, like Ready Set Baby, City Perks, Nutrien Wonderhub, and the weir.
