BYLAW NO. 9961

The Cannabis Business Licence Amendment Bylaw, 2024

The Council of the City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Cannabis Business Licence Amendment Bylaw*, 2024.

Purpose

- 2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Cannabis Business Licence Bylaw,* 2018 to:
 - (a) remove the prohibitions against:
 - (i) allowing individuals under the age of 19 on the premises;
 - (ii) employing individuals under the age of 19;
 - (iii) advertising or promoting the use of cannabis to individuals under the age of 19;
 - (iv) allowing individuals to consume cannabis on the premises; and
 - displaying images other than alpha-numeric characters and business name on advertising or signs;
 - (b) remove the requirements respecting minimum number of employees, notices indicating that no individuals under the age of 19 are permitted on the premises and window coverings; and
 - (c) make minor housekeeping amendments.

3. The Cannabis Business Licence Bylaw, 2018 is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

Section 9 Amended

4. (1) Subsection 9(1) is repealed and the following	substituted:
--	--------------

- "9. No person operating a cannabis production facility or a (1) cannabis retail store shall:
 - (a) allow an odour to emanate from the property that unreasonably interferes with the comfort, repose, health or peace of individuals of ordinary sensitivity; or
 - fail to comply with any applicable federal, provincial or (b) municipal regulation.".
- (2) Subsection 9(4) is repealed.

Section 15 Amended

5. Section 15 is amended by striking out "Department" wherever it appears and substituting "Division".
