

The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Amendment Bylaw, 2024

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 9962, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Amendment Bylaw, 2024* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration.

The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to amend *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Bylaw, 2010* to enable persons other than the City to conduct live tappings to water mains on City property, subject to the approval of the General Manager.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9962, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Amendment Bylaw, 2024*.

BACKGROUND

At its [February 28, 2024 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Utilities and Environment dated February 6, 2024 and resolved:

1. That the proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 8880, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Bylaw, 2010*, be approved; and
2. That the City Solicitor be requested to prepare the required amendments to Bylaw No. 8880, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Bylaw, 2010*, as outlined in the report of the Utilities and Environment Division dated February 6, 2024.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9962, *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Amendment Bylaw, 2024* for City Council’s consideration.

As a housekeeping amendment, the Bylaw updates the definition of General Manager to also include the General Manager of Utilities and Environment alongside the General Manager of Transportation and Construction, as both General Managers share responsibility for administration of *The Private Sewer and Water Service Connection Bylaw, 2010*.
