I strongly urge all members of council to support these motions.

I am a member of the University community and commuter cyclist. I would like add my voice to the chorus of calls for the city to take action to improve safety for cyclists at College and Wiggins. I ride through this intersection regularly and have had my share of close calls. It could easily have been me or one of my students killed there.

I have written to the city over the years voicing concerns about this intersection as I know many others have. The reality is that cyclists moving north onto campus from anywhere west of Preston have few good options. Wiggins provides the only route to the center of campus that does not involve riding on a sidewalk, hopping a curb, or riding on a narrow pedestrian filled path. We need to do better.

I know that fixing this problem will be a long process. Councillor Block's motions are the first step toward solving these problems. I urge you to support these motions.
