I was dismayed to see that none of the cycling specific recommendations (numbers 8, 9, and 10) were supported by administration at this time. I understand that this is a difficult intersection but the safety audit showed that it is not safe for cyclists as it currently stands. It has also been shown that this is the busiest intersection in Saskatoon for cyclists. It is only a matter of time before there is another incident at this intersection if we do nothing. While number 8 is not a perfect solution it would be easy to implement. As for the no right turn on red being a one-off in the city there are many examples of one- offs in other places. One that comes to mind is the 23rd Street Bus Mall where cars are not allowed. I believe that recommendation 9 is the best solution and should be implemented as soon as possible.
