Dundonald Avenue Solar Farm Project Options

Recommendation of the Committee

- 1. That Option 3, Implement Phases 1, 2, and 3 (Full Scope), be approved as the design and construction plan for Capital Project P.01955 Utility Solar Scale Energy Implementation;
- 2. That a budget increase to Capital Project P.01955 Utility Solar Scale Energy Implementation in the amount of \$4.07 million, funded by \$1.84 million from the Electrical Distribution Extension Reserve and \$2.23 million through borrowing, subject to a public hearing and intent to borrow report, be approved;
- That a budget increase to Capital Project P.01955 Utility Solar Scale Energy Implementation in the amount of \$2,566,550, funded by the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program, be approved; and
- That Capital Project P.01955 Utility Solar Scale Energy Implementation be exempted from the 10% downpayment provision required for capital projects funded through borrowing as stated in Council Policy No. C03-027 – Borrowing for Capital Projects.
