To: The Standing Policy Committee on Transportation,

I'm an avid year-round cyclist and I greatly appreciate the existing bicycle routes and marked corridors for sharing the streets with autos and cyclists. However, many routes lack connectivity, ending abruptly. The two proposals being brought forward at this meeting are actions I wish you to endorse as they are positive additions to the cycling network.

Regarding item:

- 7.1.1 – Connecting 2nd Avenue/3rd Avenue: Walking, Cycling, and Driving Improvements [TS2024-0504] This includes the recommendation for Option 2B, which would add safety features along the merging stretch of 2nd and 3rd Avenues, such as pedestrian actuated signals and a separated shared-use pathway.

The construction of pedestrian actuated signals and a separated shared-use path together with widening the route will increase the safety of both pedestrians and cyclists

Regarding item:

- 7.1.2 – Opportunities for Rapid Deployment of Safety Improvements on Active Transportation Routes – May 2024 Update [CC2023-0602, TS2023-1003, TS2023-1204] This includes the recommendation for Option 2, which would implement a Neighbourhood Bikeway using Rapid Deployment on Route 6 (Munroe Avenue to 14th) as early as next year, with additional sections to follow as funding is approved.

I would be excited to use a bikeway along Route 6
