Dear Mayor and Council,

I wish to briefly comment on these items.

Regarding Item 8.2.1, I am in favour of option 2A, Widening to the West with a Separate Pathway away from the road. I am a regular user of the pathway between on 14th St. between Cumberland Ave. and Circle Drive, and I definitely appreciate the distance I have from the street, and feel it is to the benefit of pedestrians to develop future pathways similarly whenever possible.

Regarding Item 8.2.2, I am in favour of option 2 (rapid development of Route 6), as I feel that developing a bikeway on Monroe Ave would benefit the neighbourhood and wider community, encourage greater (safer) active transportation to the University and RUH, and synergize well with existing and future active transportation infrastructure as well as the Bus Rapid Transit. As an aside, I do also want to voice my support for expanding this bikeway all the way down to Clarence Ave. at Circle Drive, recognizing that the Item as motioned is currently only considering between College Drive and 14th St.
