Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Procedures and Committees Amendment Bylaw, 2024 (No. 2).*

Purpose

- 2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Procedures and Committees Bylaw,* 2014 to:
 - (a) amend the order of business for regularly scheduled Council Committee meetings;
 - (b) remove approval of Tag Days from the list of powers or duties delegated to the Finance Committee; and
 - (c) remove the granting of vending rights to special events on public property from the list of powers or duties delegated to the Transportation Committee.
