
## **Corridor Growth Boundary Amendments**







Detailed maps of the Corridor Growth Area boundary amendments are included below:

Blairmore map 1 – The removed sites had a divided block-face. Sites were added and removed because of the proximity to future Bus Rapid Transit Station.


Blairmore map 2 – added and removed sites to prevent a divided block-face






## Woodlawn

Map 1 – removed due to the proximity to future bus rapid transit station locations




Lawson map 1 – adjustments made to prevent a divided block face. Sites were removed because the alternative to increase the boundary was too far from the proposed bus rapid transit station location, with limited connectivity. Some sites were added prevent a divided block face.



University Heights map 1 – sites were added to prevent multiple instances where the block-face is divided. Some sites were removed to prevent a division in the block-face.


University Heights Map 2 – sites were added to prevent the division of a block face and the properties were included across the street for continuity.



Nutana Map 1 – Sites were added for continuity along 10<sup>th</sup> Street and the proximity Unit to the Bus Rapid Transit System. 
8<sup>th</sup> Street Map 2 – Sites were added to prevent multiple instances of a divided block face,

8<sup>th</sup> Street Map 3 - Sites were added to prevent multiple instances of a divided block face. This area is unique because sections of it are within a close proximity to multiple Bus Rapid Transit lines.



Preston map 1– sites were added to prevent a divided block-face. Consideration was given to the proximity of green space.

Preston map 2 – sites were added and removed to prevent a divided block-face. Consideration was given to the proximity of green space.



Holmwood map 1 – sites were added and removed to prevent a divided block face. Consideration was given to connectivity to the proposed bus rapid transit system.
