Process to Identify Opportunities for Rapid Deployment

The following process was used in identifying the opportunities for rapid deployment:

- The routes with approved functional plans (i.e., shelf-ready) were identified and reviewed. This assessment is provided in <u>Appendix 2</u> of the April 2024 <u>report</u> on Opportunities for Rapid Deployment of Safety Improvements on Active Transportation Routes.
- Routes identified in the Active Transportation Plan and the Saskatoon
 Transportation Master Plan were identified and reviewed for potential rapid
 deployment. This assessment is provided in <u>Appendix 2</u> of the April 2024 <u>report</u>
 on Opportunities for Rapid Deployment of Safety Improvements on Active
 Transportation Routes.
- 3. Other key areas where comparable safety benefits could be expected and where planning for permanent solutions is not yet underway were reviewed.
- 4. Input from Active Transportation Advisory Group (ATAG).
- Connections to existing all ages and abilities (AAA) active transportation and/or cycling routes.
- Connections to key land uses such as hospitals and schools and challenging intersections where concerns have previously been raised by active transportation users.
