Dear Council,

I was appalled to learn that our Council is considering putting highways through the NE and small swales. There is so little natural land left! These tiny patches of native grassland and wetlands support a wide range of life, including at least 49 species listed as Species of Conservation Concern. We all know that biodiversity is shrinking, and that this will hurt us. Now is the time to slow down, not hasten, our environment's degradation.

City Council has been asked to endorse a plan, developed by the provincial Ministry, for 10 and 8 lanes of high-speed traffic through the Swales. The damage and degradation this development will cause is well documented.
