## Comments:

I would ask the the Municipal Planning Commission raise concern over the Blairmore Sector Plan Amendment. Reviewing the phasing plan, the south and southwest area of the sector has been excluded from development for many decades. This area is the only proposed industrial in the Blairmore Sector yet this Plan handcuffs all of it. Note that a portion of this future industrial land is already part of a Saskatoon neighbourhood - Agpro Industrial. Residential development on the west side of Saskatoon is extremely slow, and given the phasing plan I would estimate the City will not have underground services available to the industrial area for 30 plus years.

The City has done a great job of designating land uses here, but there is significant missed opportunity and economic growth by not finding a different servicing strategy to bring these lands online sooner.

I implore MPC to recommend the Blairmore Sector Plan undergo further servicing review and strategizing (i.e. lift station and off-peak pumping) such that the south and southwest industrial lands can be serviced in the short-term.
