
## **OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN NOTICE**

PROPOSED OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN MAP AMENDMENTS – BYLAW NOS. 9999, 10000, 10001, 10002, 10003, 10004, 10005 THE OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2024 (Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9)

Saskatoon City Council will consider amendments to Bylaw No. 9700, the Official Community Plan, proposed by City of Saskatoon - Planning and Development Department to change the land use designation of various sites along the future Bus Rapid Transit routes within the "Corridor Growth Area". By way of Bylaw Nos. 9999, 10000, 10001, 10002, 10003, 10004, The Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw, 2024 (Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8), the sites are proposed to be re-designated on Official Community Plan Map 4 - Land Use as outlined in



this notice. Additionally, by way of Bylaw No. 10005, The Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw, 2024 (No. 9), the Corridor Growth boundary is proposed to be altered on Official Community Plan Map 3 - Planned Growth as outlined in this notice and adding a provision to Section F2.1 Land Use Map to enable future oriented land uses that may not be consistent with current zoning.



**REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT** – The proposed amendments align with the Corridor Growth policyframework established in the Official Community Plan and is supported by various City plans including the Growth Plan to Half a Million (2016), Corridor Transformation Plan (2020), and Housing Accelerator Fund Action Plan (2023). The proposed land use changes and Corridor Growth boundary alterations are intended to represent a long-term vision regarding the types of development the City would encourage in the future in these areas, if and when individual landowners bring forward rezoning and development proposals.
