I wish to address Council on the following matters:

1. the proposed amendments to the OCP and Zoning Bylaw are ill-conceived from both a planning and infrastructure prospective with negative effects which far outweigh any benefit which may be gained from the HAF;
2. the proposed amendments are a massive overreach which bear little or no relationship to the proposed use of the HAF;
3. the existing Infill Regulations and Transit Corridor Plan are sufficient to deal with increasing density of development. If they eventually prove insufficient, changes can be made incrementally; and,
4. the procedure whereby these amendments are being considered is rushed and problematic.
