As a lifelong Saskatoon resident, I believe that the proposed zoning changes to allow for increased density in new developments in the area of the BRT corridor would be a net positive for the city: both because it would allow people to have the freedom to choose where they want to live, rather than be forced to live in the Scylla of North American suburbia or the Charybdis of gigantic tower blocks, and because allowing increased density in new developments around the BRT corridors will cost far less for the city than continuing to sprawl out onto valuable farmland as most of the infrastructure is already in place, with a lot of the infrastructure having the capacity to handle more people than currently use it.
