Comments:

I would like to speak in support of the Housing Action Plan to increase the availability of affordable housing, particularly near the Bus Rapid Transit lines.

My work puts me in close contact with people who are struggling financially, and recently, the vast majority of those struggles centre around a disproportionate amount of income going to housing.

I am hopeful that the Housing Action Plan will increase the stock of available housing in Saskatoon and would like to see action taking very quickly once the plan is approved. I would also like to see the City commit to working with the Saskatoon Housing Authority to address housing for populations that are under-served in Saskatoon, like families (where wait times for subsidized housing can exceed 18 months) and single adults under the age of 55.

I welcome the opportunity to fill empty spaces in our city with homes for those who need them, and to gather more individuals and families on 'single unit' lots. I hope the use of housing space in this way encourages increased use of parks where we can all share space and have an increased sense of community.
