

REASON FOR THE AMENDMENT – The proposed rezoning will provide for a 26-storey High Density Mixed-Use development comprised of a variety of residential and commercial land uses. A Zoning Agreement is proposed for the site, which is a legal agreement that establishes sitespecific regulations for how a property may be developed and used. The proposed development would provide for:

- Approximately 260 dwelling units comprised of a mix of Multiple Unit Dwelling, Boarding Apartment and street-oriented Townhouse land uses;
- Approximately 2,100m2 of commercial space; and
- Four levels of parking, including underground and surface parking accessed through 12th Street East and Saskatchewan Crescent East.

A corresponding application to amend the Official Community Plan in relation to this site is also proposed.
