

APPROVAL REPORT

The Transit Fares Amendment Bylaw, 2024

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 10033, *The Transit Fares Amendment Bylaw, 2024* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw amends *The Transit Fares Bylaw, 2004* to implement City Council’s decision respecting implementing free child fare on Saskatoon Transit.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 10033, *The Transit Fares Amendment Bylaw, 2024*.

BACKGROUND

At its [June 26, 2024 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services Division dated June 4, 2024, and resolved in part:

That the City Solicitor be directed to make the necessary amendments to *The Transit Fares Bylaw, 2004*, as outlined in report dated June 4, 2024 of the Transportation and Construction Division.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 10033, *The Transit Fares Amendment Bylaw, 2024* for City Council’s consideration.

The housekeeping amendment repeals the definition of “undergraduate”. This amendment removes an unnecessary definition that is not referenced or used in *The Transit Fares Bylaw, 2004*.
