5. The purpose and intent of this Agreement is to address the issues which are specific to providing police services to the Land, and to ensure a harmonious working relationship between the parties.

Authorizations

Provision of Policing Services

- 7. (1) The parties agree that, as part of the provision of City services to the Land, the Board shall provide all normal policing services to the Land and the occupants of the Land, being the same policing services it provides to other lands and occupants within the City, provided however, and it is understood and agreed, that by entering into this Agreement, Peter Ballantyne is not acknowledging that the Board has the right to provide policing services to the Land without Peter Ballantyne's consent, and the Board is not acknowledging that it does not have the right to provide policing services to the Land without Peter Ballantyne's consent.
 - (2) Nothing in this Agreement affects the applicability or inapplicability of provincial laws of general application, including municipal bylaws, to the Land.

Consultation and Cooperation

- 8. (1) The Board and Peter Ballantyne, or their representatives, agree to meet together at least once in each calendar year to address any policing issues or concerns regarding the Land. Such meetings shall include the Saskatoon Chief of Police.
 - (2) The Board agrees, through the Saskatoon Chief of Police, to provide information to the members of the Saskatoon Police Service regarding the status of the Land as reserve land, and to advise them of any operational protocols regarding the Land and the provision of police services to the

Land which may be agreed to between the Saskatoon Chief of Police and Peter Ballantyne from time to time.

Acknowledgement of Limitations on Authority

9. The parties acknowledge that the Board has only such authority regarding the provision of police services as is given to it by *The Police Act, 1990*, SS 1990-91, c P-15.01.

Liability

10. The Board shall have no greater liability to Peter Ballantyne regarding the provision of police services to the Land, than it has to all other lands and occupants within the City. All defences available to the Board under *The Police Act*, 1990 shall be available to the Board as if incorporated in this Agreement. Peter Ballantyne and the occupants of the Land shall have the same rights, remedies and recourse against the Board as would be available to them if the Land was non-reserve land.

Notice

11. Any notice required or permitted to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been given to the other party when delivered personally, by registered mail, postage prepaid, facsimile, email or other means of electronic communication capable of producing a printed copy as follows:

A party may, at any time, change its address for the above purpose by giving a notice to the other party stating the change and setting forth a new address in accordance with this Section. Any subsequent notices required or permitted to be given under this Agreement shall be given to the party at its changed address.

Term of Agreement

- 12. (1) Peter Ballantyne and the Board agree that the term of this Agreement shall be for the same duration as the Land remains reserve land as defined by the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.I-5, or any successor legislation replacing the *Indian Act*.
 - (2) This Agreement shall commence upon the Land being set apart as reserve land for the use and benefit of Peter Ballantyne.

Amendments

13. If, at any time during the continuance of this Agreement, the parties shall deem it necessary or expedient to make any alteration or addition to this Agreement, they may do so by means of a written agreement between them which shall be supplemental and form part of this Agreement.

Reasonable Assurances

14. The parties shall at all times and upon every reasonable request provide all further assurances and do such further things as are necessary for the purpose of giving full effect to the covenants and provisions contained in this Agreement.
