Please find enclosed a Police Services Agreement with respect to the property located at 1623 and 1625 Quebec Avenue for the Board's consideration at its meeting held on September 19, 2024.

Peter Ballantyne Cree Nation owns the property located at the above noted address and is requesting that the property be granted reserve status by the Federal Government. Part of the reserve creation process includes negotiation of a Municipal Services and Compatibility Agreement. City Council will be considering this Agreement at its Regular Business Meeting on September 25, 2024. A signing ceremony to mark this occasion is being planned for a later date and you will be contacted as these plans are being finalized.

As with other Police Services Agreements, the purpose of the proposed Police Services Agreement is to make it clear that the Saskatoon Police Service will be providing policing to the property as part of the services which Peter Ballantyne Cree Nation pays for with its annual fee-for-service as set out in the Municipal Services and Compatibility Agreement.
